Worship Services Guidelines in the Sanctuary

For the health and safety of those who choose to attend worship in person, we have implemented the following:

- 1) If you are feeling sick or are uncomfortable joining us for worship in person, please stay home and join us via streaming, radio, or TV broadcast.
- 2) Face masks are encouraged but not required.
- 3) Please socially distance before, during and after the service. Unfortunately, that means no greeters before or after the service.
- 4) Please seat yourself. Seating will be in alternating rows of pews. Family groups are encouraged to sit together, but please remain 6 feet away from other persons in your same pew.
- 5) Overflow seating is available in the Fellowship Hall if the sanctuary becomes too full for safe distancing.
- 6) Bring your personal Bible for use if you wish.
- 7) There will be no coffee provided, but you are welcome to bring your own beverage from home.
- 8) We will not be passing an offering plate. Offerings may be placed in baskets by the front and rear entrances, mailed to the office, or dropped off during weekdays.
- 9) Hand sanitizer dispensers are in various locations around the church building for your use.
- 10) The Toddler Nursery is now open. Temperature checks are required for all children and adults entering the nursery room. The Infant nursery will remain closed.
- 11) We encourage the congregation to continue engaging in small group fellowship and individual study of God's word in your homes.

Offerings – If you are not attending the service, your offering may be dropped off at the office during office hours or mailed in. If the office is closed when you come, just slide it under the office door for security.

If you have been considering using an automatic form of payment, you may contact the office for instructions.

Credit Card giving – we have an Online Giving button on our centralreformed.org website that will let you make offerings by credit card. (Do not select the "Bank" option). You should print a donation receipt if donating by credit card.

Suggested items are:

School supplies: pens, crayons or markers, pencils, sharpeners, stamps and ink pads, paper, coloring or picture books.

Toys: small cars, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yos, jump ropes, but no toys that require batteries.

Hygiene items: toothbrush, comb, bar soap (in plastic bag), washcloth, etc.

Other: t-shirts, socks, ball caps, sunglasses, hair clips, toy jewelry.

Do NOT include: toothpaste, used or damaged items; war related items such as toy guns, knives or military figures; chocolate, candy or food; liquids or lotions; vitamins, glass or aerosol cans, or items needing batteries.
